The Lord will fight for you

The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still. (Exodus 14:14)

God's mercies are new each morning

²¹ Yet this I call to mind and therefore I have hope: ²² Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. ²³ They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. (Lamentations 3:21-23)

God will renew your strength

But those who trust in the Lord will become strong again. They will be like eagles that grow new feathers. They will run and not get weak. They will walk and not get tired. (Isaiah 40:31)

The Lord will help you

You will look for the people who were against you, but you will not be able to find them. Those who fought against you will disappear completely. (Isaiah 41:13)

The Lord will be with you

When you have troubles, I am with you. When you cross rivers, you will not be hurt. When you walk through fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not hurt you. (Isaiah 43:2)

God's love will never end

The mountains may disappear, and the hills may become dust, but my faithful love will never leave you. I will make peace with you, and it will never end. The Lord who loves you said this. (Isaiah 54:10)

No weapon will overtake me

People will make weapons to fight against you, but their weapons will not defeat you. Some people will say things against you, but anyone who speaks against you will be proved wrong. (Isaiah 54:17)

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. (James 4:8)

God works for your good

We know that in everything God works for the good of those who love him. These are the people God chose, because that was his plan. (Romans 8:28)

God's peace will guard you

Because you belong to Christ Jesus, God's peace will stand guard over all your thoughts and feelings. His peace can do this far better than our human minds. (Philippians 4:7)

God gives good gifts

You people are so bad, but you still know how to give good things to your children. So surely your heavenly Father will give good things to those who ask him. (Matthew 7:11)

Jesus will give you rest

Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. (Matthew 11:28)

You will have a full life

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. (John 10:10)

God's love lasts forever

From far away, the Lord will appear to his people. The Lord says, "I love you people with a love that continues forever. That is why I have continued showing you kindness." (Jeremiah 31:3)

God will never forget you

¹⁵ But the Lord says, can a woman forget her baby? Can she forget the child who came from her body? Even if she can forget her children, I cannot forget you. ¹⁶ I drew a picture of you on my hand. You are always before my eyes. (Isaiah 49:15-16)

You have a hope and a future

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. (Jeremiah 29:11)

God will teach and guide you

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you. (Psalm 32:8)

I say this because I know the plans that I have for you. This message is from the Lord. I have good plans for you. I don't plan to hurt you. I plan to give you hope and a good future. (Jeremiah 29:11)

You have received grace and peace

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (Philemon 1:3)

God is your light and salvation

The Lord is my light and my salvation – whom should I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life – of whom should I be afraid? (Psalm 21:1)

The Lord hears you

The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles. (Psalm 34:17)

God will deliver you

Call on me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me. (Psalm 50:15)

God's love is abounding

You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to you. (Psalm 86:5)

God will bless you

God can give you more blessings than you need, and you will always have plenty of everything. You will have enough to give to every good work. (2 Corinthians 9:8)

God will give you rest

Accept my work and learn from me. I am gentle and humble in spirit. And you will find rest for your souls. (Matthew 11:29)

Jesus is the way, the truth and life

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

Jesus is the light of the world

Later, Jesus talked to the people again. He said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never live in darkness. They will have the light that gives life." (John 8:12)

God's peace is with you

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. (John 14:27)

God chose you to bear fruit

You did not choose me. I chose you. And I gave you this work: to go and produce fruit – fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you anything you ask for in my name. (John 15:16)

You have eternal life

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16)

Jesus is the bread of life

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." (John 6:35)

You belong to God

Whoever belongs to God hears what God says. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God. (John 8:47)

God is your hiding place and surrounds you with songs

You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance. (Psalm 32:7)

God protects you from the evil one

But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one. (2 Thessalonians 3:3)

God provides a way out of temptation

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. (1 Corinthians 10:13)

God will comfort you

As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you; and you will be comforted over Jerusalem. (Isaiah 66:13)

God is love

Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. (1 John 4:8)

You have victory over death

When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory." (1 Corinthians 15:54)

You have life and godliness

His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. (2 Peter 1:3)

Nothing is impossible with God

For no word from God will ever fail. (Luke 1:37)

God is your stronghold

The Lord is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble. (Psalm 9:9)

He satisfies your desires with good things

Who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. (Psalm 103:5)

God's joy is your strength

Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength." (Nehemiah 8:10)

God will pour out his Spirit on all

And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions. (Joel 2:28)

God will give you a new heart

I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. (Ezekiel 36:26)

God is good

The Lord is good to all; he has compassion on all he has made. (Psalm 145:9)

When God's love endures forever

For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations. (Psalm 100:5)

God is trustworthy

Lord, you are God! Your covenant is trustworthy, and you have promised these good things to your servant. (2 Samuel 7:28)

God's Word is trustworthy

The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple. (Psalm 19:7)

God is your refuge

The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him. (Nahum 1:7)

No one can snatch you from God's hand

I give them eternal life, and they will never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand. (John 10:28)

Jesus is the resurrection and the life

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die." (John 11:25)

God will remain in you

Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. (John 15:4)

The Holy Spirit will guide you to all truth

But when the Spirit of truth comes, he will lead you into all truth. He will not speak his own words. He will speak only what he hears and will tell you what will happen in the future. (John 16:13)

Jesus has overcome the world

I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world. (John 16:33)

God cares for you

Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. (1 Peter 5:7)

God will make you strong and firm

And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm, and steadfast. (1 Peter 5:10)

Jesus makes us righteous when we believe in him

This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference between Jew and Gentile. (Romans 3:22)

You are under grace

For sin should no longer be your master because you are not under the law, but under grace. (Romans 6:14)

You are not condemned

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. (Romans 8:1)

Your joy is complete in Christ

I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. (John 15:1)

You are saved through faith

⁸ For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – ⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8-9)

God will give you wisdom

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. (James 1:5)

Christ paid for our sins through his death

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole". (Galatians 3:13)

God is your shield

As for God, his way is perfect: The Lord's word is flawless; he shields all who take refuge in him. (Psalm 18:30)

You are a new person in Christ

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! (2 Corinthians 5:17)

You are blessed with every spiritual blessing

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. (Ephesians 1:3)

God will finish the work he began in you

Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 1:6)

Your name is written in heaven

However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven. (Luke 10:20)

The Lord is your Banner

Moses built an altar and called it The Lord is my Banner. (Exodus 17:15)

The Lord grants favor and honor

For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord grants us favor and honor; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless. (Psalm 84:11)

God will make your paths straight

In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. (Proverbs 3:6)

The righteous lack no good thing

The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the Lord lack no good thing. (Psalm 34:10)

God hears your prayer

Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. (Jeremiah 29:12)

The Lord is near

The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth. (Psalm 145:18)

God will give you comfort

Even if I walk through a valley as dark as the grave, I will not be afraid of any danger, because you are with me. Your rod and staff comfort me. (Psalm 23:4)

God's love fills the earth

The earth is filled with your love, Lord; teach me your decrees. (Psalm 119:64)

You are not a slave to fear

The Spirit that we received is not a spirit that makes us slaves again and causes us to fear. The Spirit that we have makes us God's chosen children. And with that Spirit we cry out, "Abba, Father."
(Romans 8:15)

You are a child of God

The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. (Romans 8:16)

God works all things for your good

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. (Romans 8:28)

You are more than a conqueror

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. (Romans 8:37)

Nothing can separate you from God's love

Neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:39)

Perfect love drives out fear

There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love. (1 John 4:18)

God is able to keep you from falling

To him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy. (Jude 1:24)

Jesus is preparing a place for you

² My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. (John 14:2-3)

The Lord will watch over you

The Lord will protect you as you come and go, both now and forever! (Psalm 121:8)

God will never let the righteous fall

Give your worries to the Lord, and he will care for you. He will never let those who are good be defeated. (Psalm 55:22)

The Spirit in you bears fruit

²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. (Galatians 5:22-23)

You are chosen, holy and dearly loved

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. (Colossians 3:12)

You have a spirit of power, love, and self-discipline

For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love, and self-discipline. (2 Timothy 1:7)
