Jesus Drives Out an Evil Spirit

Mark 1:21-28

²¹ They went out to Capernaum [kah-PER-nay-yum], and when the Sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. ²² The people were amazed at his teaching because he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law. ²³ Just then a man in their synagogue who was possessed by an evil spirit cried out, ²⁴ "What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are – the Holy One of God!"

²⁵ "Be quiet!" said Jesus sternly. "Come out of him!" ²⁶ The evil spirit shook the man violently and came out of him with a shriek.

²⁷ The people were all so amazed that they asked each other, "What is this? A new teaching – and one with authority! He even gives orders to evil spirits, and they obey him." ²⁸ News about him spread quickly over the whole region of Galilee. (NIV)
