# Walking in Prayer: Old Testament

## Lesson 9: A Time of Prayer

### Activity:

In Lesson 8, we learned from Ezra, Jeremiah, and Daniel about the importance of confessing sin, as well as faithfulness in marriage and dating. We learned how to pray honest prayers during times of persecution and suffering. Even as we saw God discipline our world, we saw the power of the spiritual gifts that he gives to his people: the gifts of prophecy, vision, and wisdom. Even through the worst of times, we saw God promise his people eternal life. Finally, we learned what it means to be faithful to God, even to the point of death.

Share one way that your life or relationship with God was impacted from the last lesson. In what ways do you still want to grow?

In this lesson, we will walk in prayer together. Using your prayer cards, take turns praying through your cards one at a time, beginning with a time of worship, thanksgiving, and confession of sin.

Feel free to cry out to God, raise your hands in praise, kneel, stand – whatever you need to do to express your deepest desires and emotions to God. Remove all distractions, prepare your hearts, and expect to experience God's power and Spirit during this special time!
